

Holes Homework Project

- You are going to complete a homework project linked to Holes.
- You will have to choose tasks from the table below- your total must add up to at least 100 points.
- Your project must be completed by two weeks before Christmas. There will be 2 'checking' dates before this when you will have to bring some work in to show your progress.

<p>Create a quiz on either the author or the novel. It must have at least 20 questions and an answer sheet. I expect more than true or false!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Do some research on Texas. Create a fact file about Texas and include a map and images. You should also include research into climate, music, famous Texans.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Research poisonous American reptiles. Create a fact file with pictures.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Read one of Louis Sacher's other novels. You must write a chapter summary for each chapter and a review of the book.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">50 points</p>
<p>Do two sketches of costumes from the novel. Label them carefully and include the fabric that they were made from. Remember to state the character! You might want to design an actual costume for a film version of the novel.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">30 points</p>	<p>Create a diary for a kid who is a member of an American street gang.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Research the American Civil War and the treatment of black Americans and/or the abolition of slavery.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">30 points</p>	<p>Find a key moment in Stanley's life from the novel. Write a monologue from his point of view- at least one side of A4. (eg when the teacher compares Stanley's weight to another student in maths)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>
<p>Write a persuasive essay as Stanley, persuading the campers that they need to protest against the injustices of Camp Green Lake and demand that conditions at the camp change for the better. At least one A4 side.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Create a Holes 'playlist'. I want a song for each character and why that song would be their favourite song. I do not want a run-down of the current top 40 chart!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>Write a contemporary newspaper article set in old Camp Green Lake. You must write about something to do with the novel – such as an article about Kate Barlow.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">30 points</p>	<p>Create a quiz book, based on Holes. At least 8 pages of activities.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">30 points</p>
<p>Do a comic strip of <i>Holes</i>. You can choose how to set it out, but you must include key scenes and full colour. I have high expectations of this activity.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">40 points</p>	<p>Create the DVD case of the novel. You must set it out like a proper DVD case. You choose actors. (They are making a film of the novel too!)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">30 points</p>	<p>Write a selection of poetry about events in the novel. You might want to write a rap song instead!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">20 points</p>	<p>An idea of your choice! You might be handy with the video camera, or excited about making models- run your idea past me and I will decide how many points it is worth!</p>
