<p>TI 7 points (Approx. time 45h)</p>	<p>Perform in the Horsforth School Musical Theatre Scenes from *****_***** of March</p>
<p>LA 6 points (Approx. time 15h)</p>	<p>Attend every rehearsal for one of the department's extra curricular activities.</p>
<p>SO 5 points (Approx. time 3h+)</p>	<p>Book and use a practise room at least three times this term to work on a piece you are performing in class.</p>
<p>FA 4 points (Approx. time 2h)</p>	<p>Compose a song that can be used as a revision aid for another subject</p>
<p>MI 3 points (Approx. time 1h)</p>	<p>Book and use a practise room once this term to work on a piece you are performing in class.</p>
<p>RE 2 points (Approx. time 45m)</p>	<p>Support your peers by attending the Musical Theatre Scenes and giving a review online.</p>
<p>DO 1 point (Approx. time 30m)</p>	<p>Listen to a piece of Blues music by Louis Armstrong and comment on how it differs to the music you are used to listening to.</p>
