



GCSE RESULTS 2016

We are very pleased to report that at Horsforth School, 78% of students achieved 5 or more A*-C grades including English and mathematics at GCSE, with over 25% of all grades awarded at A* or A. This performance continues the excellent track record of academic success of Horsforth students and consolidates the school's position as one of the top non-selective schools in the region.

Dr Bell, Horsforth School's Headteacher, said; 'These excellent GCSE results come exactly a week after a further year of record breaking A2 results, where over one third of all grades were awarded at A* or A. Both sets of results are a reward for all the hard work of our students and staff.

A-LEVEL RESULTS 2016

Horsforth School's staff and students are once again exceptionally pleased with the excellent A-level results achieved this summer. All of our Year 13 students have left with at least two A-level qualifications and 87% of students left with three good A level passes. This, combined with a 100% pass-rate for the sixth consecutive year, has ensured that all of our students will progress successfully.

Over a third of all grades were awarded at A*/A and a 'typical' Horsforth student left our Sixth Form with the equivalent of A Level grades at ABB.

Our staff are rightly proud of the exceptional results gained this year and our thanks go not only to them for their professionalism, but to our Governors, parents and carers who have been so supportive over many years.
