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Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you to share with you a new remote learning timetable that we would like your son/daughter to follow for the final 3 weeks of the school term. The government guidelines have left Year 7, 8 and 9 students with no face to face contact and as a result little interaction with their teachers. The new timetable will ensure your son/daughter gets much more pre-recorded or live lessons leading up to the summer break.

The new timetable will **completely replace** your son/daughter's current timetable and will be the one that they should follow lesson by lesson from **Monday 29th June**. Lessons with green behind the subject will be the pre-recorded or live lessons set by teachers using the google classroom. Any lesson where the subject has white behind it will be 'normal' set work with no pre-recorded or live lesson set by the teacher.

A summary of the key points I talk through in the video are:

- w/c 29th June is week 1
- Students will just follow this new timetable and not their current timetable of lessons found at the back of their planner.
- Where the timetable is coloured in green that is where new content will be taught, either pre-recorded input from their teachers or using Googlemeet/Zoom: it is really important that they watch these. Their teacher will let them know via the Googleclassroom. They might upload this BEFORE the lessons take place, for example at the start of the week, so students must read the instructions for each subject carefully.
- Where the lessons are white; independent work will still be set using the Googleclassroom for students to complete. E.G. Hegerty Maths or Seneca Learning.

I hope that students enjoy these lessons more with a familiar face and if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact school.
