We will be using these new facilities for our Sixth Form students and use the space freed up in the main school for the lower years. This will mean we will be able to offer dedicated A level facilities on the scale and quality of a Sixth Form college whilst retaining the support and care of a dedicated community school.

It's been great to get to visit other schools again for meetings and to share ideas and good practice. I am always grateful for these opportunities and it always makes me reflect on Horsforth and how lucky I am to have such great staff and wonderful students. I hope that the coming year will allow more of these opportunities so we can share our good work and so we can continue to learn from others.
