Julius Caesar Theatre Trip

Year 7 enjoyed a fantastic performance of the Royal Shakespeare Company's touring production Julius Caesar this week. They are about to start studying this Shakespeare play so now have some ideas about what they are going to be learning. The students enjoyed a superb view of the stage from the second and third row of the stalls and were particularly delighted by the actor who sat next to them to speak her lines. Numerous members of the public stopped the staff afterwards to say how well behaved they thought the students were. It really was a special night.

Lord of the Flies Theatre Trip

Year 9s were treated to a production of Lord of Flies at the Leeds Playhouse at the end of March which brought to life a text they had read in class. The production re-imagined the story by casting both male and female actors in the lead roles. Some were fresh out of theatre school in their first professional show. From the opening scene of the plane crash to the climax, students were treated to an excellent production.

Career Opportunity for Year 11 and Year 12 Students with PricewaterhouseCoopers International Limited (PWC)

PWC are running a 3-day **Virtual Insight Programme**, on **24-26 July 2023**. This is open to **Year 11 and 12 students** and the 3-day experience is designed to give students an insight into PwC: their lines of service, culture, the work they do and how students can join them as a school leaver. Students will have the opportunity to engage with PWC staff and ask questions so that they can make informed decisions about their next steps. Students will receive guidance and top tips on the application process, equipping them with the skills they need to thrive in the workplace.
